**Reminders for Fellows and Fellow Candidates**

See the *Supervision Application* for the counselors information. It is recommended to pencil in the other required spaces just prior to each supervision meeting. The pertinent information to do so is found on the counselors *Case Reports*.

The ACBC Board of Trustees has clarified the supervision requirements as being 50 separate counseling sessions of approximately 1 hour in length, discussed in *at least* 10 conversations with the supervising Fellow, within one year. There *is* an acceptable, 30 min session-length leeway (*past* the 1 hour), on occasion. But candidates should keep session-time within 10 minutes of the 1 hour generally.

ACBC's legal documents require the counselor to record *at least* 5 counseling sessions for your review. There is value in listening to one or two audios early in counseling, two or three more later but within the first 25-30 sessions, and the remaining one nearer the end of the 50 sessions. Any supervisor who deems it necessary may require an additional audio session or two. The Sessions listened to should be clearly identified on the *Supervision Log*.

When communicating with the ACBC office concerning a counselor's completion of his 50 sessions of supervision, remember to attach the candidate's *Supervision log* and the final *Supervision Evaluation* form. These will indicate by record they have met requirements, and whether or not you are recommending them for ACBC certification.
